REGISTRATION AND FEES

All 5th - 8th grade students will be able to participate, if registration and fees are completed within the proper time frame. However, the purpose of registration is to determine a fixed number of players permitted on each team. If registration exceeds that ideal number, players will be accepted based on tryouts and/or coach's discretion.

A fee of \$55.00 will be assessed for each sport a student plays. No athlete will be allowed to participate until all fees are paid. This fee is used to cover the minimum basic cost, including league fees, uniform purchase/rental, equipment, tournament and trophy cost, etc. Payment of fees does not entitle any athlete to permanent ownership of a uniform or any other equipment, nor does it guarantee new uniforms each year.

A \$5.00 reimbursement will be assessed at the end of a sport season to parents who volunteer to work at least one game during the regular game season or tournament games. This will not exceed one reimbursement per family.

All fees are due upon registration along with a mandatory-signed contract of parent and student obligations. Please make your check payable to: **C.C.S. Athletic Department.** There is a \$20.00 fee on all returned checks. Post-dated checks will not be accepted.

Athletes can register/participate in more than one sport, as long as that sport does not run simultaneously with another sport. There will be co-ed sports offered only if that sport is not offered to both genders.

REGISTRATION AND FEES (Cheerleader and Pep Club)

Cheerleader registration and fees are due after tryouts. Athletes who are interested in the cheerleading squad must participate in a three (3) day tryout. Tryouts are for athletes in grades 5th – 8th. However, 4th grade may receive a personal invitation. Cheerleading and girls basketball run simultaneously, exceptions will be considered.

- A person with a reference from a Parent/Staff of Cornerstone's Church or School.

STUDENT BYLAWS

Any violation of the rules and guidelines set forth in the bylaws will result in disciplinary action being taken against violating party(ies) as described in the Disciplinary Bylaws section of this handbook.

A student must act in a manner that reflects favorably on the school and himself/herself, displaying a Godly attitude at all times. There will be no tolerance for violence, on or off court. Also, athletes must adhere to the following:

1. Maintain a 2.0 GPA for a three-week grading period. If a student falls below this average during any time after the season has started, that student will be dismissed from the team.
2. Show respect for coaches and fully cooperate with them; respect should also be given to teammates, opponents, and officials, as well as spectators and fans.
3. Respect and maintain facilities, fields, and equipment. Parent/guardian will be liable for all/any damages caused by the student to any property or equipment.
4. Be responsible for the uniform issued.
5. Follow the bus rules that are stated in the student handbook.
6. Be present and on-time for practice and games.
7. A student will not be allowed to participate if receiving or serving a detention or a suspension on or near the day of a game or practice. This will not exceed one game per detention.
8. A student will not be allowed to attend a game or practice on the same day he or she is absent from school.
9. If a player is removed from the team by parents/guardians, a written note must be presented to the Coach and or Athletic Director regarding this decision.



PARENT BYLAWS

Any violation of the rules and guidelines set forth in the bylaws will result in disciplinary action being taken against violating party(ies) as described in the Disciplinary Bylaws section of this handbook.

Parents who resolve to take part and support the activities of Cornerstone's Athletic Program must adhere to the following bylaws:

1. Parents are responsible for picking up their athlete from all practices, home and away games. Any athlete that has not been picked up **15 minutes** after completion of practice or game, will incur EDC (Extended Day Care) charges. *See expected arrival times.*
2. Practices are a vital part of the program and are considered mandatory. Absence from practice will be a contributing factor in allocation of game playing time. If an athlete misses a practice, the coach must be notified in advance by the parent or the athlete.
3. **Parents are not allowed in the gym or on the field during practices.** The athlete needs his/her full attention on the coach.
4. Parents should be expected to support and encourage their child's efforts. Attending games and cheering the team on is a show of support. However, parents are to act in a responsible manner and show good Christian behavior. Questioning, criticizing, or berating the playing efforts of any athlete or any team, coaches, referees, or any other officials is inappropriate behavior. Parents can and will be asked to leave a game or tournament by coaches, athletic director, or referees if they are not able to maintain a standard of acceptable behavior.
5. Parents will assist the student in maintaining the athletic uniforms for the duration of the season, and assure its return. If the uniform is not returned or returns in a non-acceptable condition, the parent will be held liable for the cost to repair/replace the uniform. Academic grades will be withheld until all repair fees are paid or until the uniform is returned. This could also affect any future student's sports participation. All uniform equipment must be returned to the Athletic Department.

6. In matters of concern, the parent should make every effort to address the issue with the coach/person in question. If communication at this level fails, the matter should be addressed in order of protocol as followed:
 - < Head Coach
 - < Athletic Director
 - < Administrators
 - < School Board

DISCIPLINARY BYLAWS

The Athletic Program Staff, C.C.S. Administrators, and/or the Church Council are responsible for the implementation of any and all disciplinary action. Such action can be implemented due to misbehavior, bad language, un-excused absence, un-sportsmanlike conduct, or any violation of the statements set forth in the bylaws. Should the Athletic Department become aware of any such actions the following disciplinary process may occur:

Adult Participants (Parents, Guardians, Spectators)

1. The Athletic Director will notify the adult participant of the inappropriate conduct.
2. The adult will be required to meet with the AD and/or Program Staff, and be given the chance to defend his/her conduct. Failure to attend this meeting will be taken to mean that the adult admits to and has no defense for the inappropriate conduct.
3. The Athletic Program Staff will determine the outcome of all charges.
4. The disciplinary action will be in the form of either corrective counseling, game attendance suspension(s), or revocation of the adult's right to participate/spectate in all Cornerstone's athletic activities.

Student Participants (Players, Spectators)

- ! Immediate disciplinary action by the adult in charge will be issued for any misconduct. If the behavior persists, the procedures will be as follows:
 1. The parent/guardian will be notified of the student's inappropriate conduct.
 2. The student and parent/guardian will be required to meet with the AD and/or Program Staff, and be given the chance to defend their conduct. Failure to attend will be considered an admission of guilt.
 3. The Athletic Program Staff will determine the outcome of all charges.

- ! The disciplinary action could result in the following:
 1. Reduced playing time.
 2. Non-starter, if applicable.
 3. Sitting on sidelines during practice and/or games.
 4. Suspension from the team for a determined period of time.
 5. Expulsion from the team, restricting entrance to any Cornerstone Athletic event.

TEAM FRAMEWORK

The team framework consists of students grades 5th and 6th at Junior Varsity(JV) level and grades 7th and 8th at Varsity level. Fourth grade students may be able to participate at the invitation of the Athletic Director, if there are openings available.

Varsity team athletes will not participate in any JV sport, however a JV athlete will be allowed to participate at Varsity level, at the Head Coach and/or Athletic Director's discretion.

Cornerstone Christian School builds the team framework as follows:

PEP Club Openings will be available for 8 – 10 members for grades 4th – 8th. Any greater number will be at the Athletic Director's discretion.

Cheerleading Openings will be available for 8 (eight) at JV level, and 12 (twelve) at Varsity level. Any greater number will be at the Athletic Director's discretion. There will be 2 (two) to 3 (three) tryout practice dates followed by tryouts to determine these 18 (eighteen) athletes to make up this team framework.

Girls Volleyball Played at JV and Varsity level. The ideal number of players is 9 (nine), this number will not exceed 12 (twelve) players per team.

Soccer Currently a co-ed sport, built with grades 5th through 8th. The ideal number of players is 12 (twelve), this will not exceed 15 (fifteen).

Boys Basketball Played at JV and Varsity level. The ideal number of players per team is 12 (twelve), this will not exceed 15 (fifteen)

Girls Basketball One team, grades 5th through 8th. The ideal number of players is 12 (twelve), this will not exceed 15 (fifteen).



CRITERIA FOR SPORT TEAM LEADERSHIP

Leader: to direct by influence, to show the way, as by going before, one that leads by guiding.

It is a special honor to be chosen as team leader. The choice of leadership will be made by the Head Coach and/or Athletic Director, as well as according to the following criteria:

- < Must attend each practice and game or notify the coach of any unusual situations.
- < Must be on time so that others are shown a good example.
- < Must be cooperative with the coach and players.
- < Must have a Godly attitude toward coach and teammates at all times.
- < Must have a faithful and dedicated, sacrificial attitude towards the team.

PLAYING TIME

If a player is only interested in getting playing time, his/her desire may lead to frustration on his/her part, causing a poor attitude that will affect the team. It is essential that the athlete/parent realize that humility (*being humble*) is part of playing on a team. Overcoming this obstacle can be achieved when every athlete/parent understands that the player lends value to the team regardless of his/her role. However, each player's amount of playing time will be reflective of his/her ability, effort, attendance at practices and commitment, as well as at the coach's discretion. However, playing time for all will be encouraged.

Missing practice without cause, or excessive absences, can result in reduced playing time and even exclusion from the team. The Head Coach or Athletic Director may also reduce playing time as a disciplinary action if a player loses self-control or engages in other conduct unbecoming to a Christian athlete.

All uniform equipment will be collected by the Athletic Director and or Coach at the end of each Sport season, after the last official game. If your child does not plan to attend the last official game, prior arrangements must be made with the AD for uniform collections



TRANSPORTATION

Students will be transported by bus to and from away practices and away games. Please make arrangements for your child to be picked up by the expected arrival time. During away games and away practices students are to be picked up at the south door of the school. During home games and home practices students are to be picked up at the Multi-Purpose Building. If the student attends EDC, or has not been picked up within the 15 minute time frame, he/she will be escorted to the EDC classroom in the school building.

Students are expected to follow the bus rules that are stated in the student handbook. No radios or walkmans, eating and drinking or gum chewing on the bus.
